Work closely with the Performance Coaching & Sport Science/Medicine team to design and implement high quality periodised training and competition programmes for targeted players (IPP), aligned with the Netball Performance model (WITTW: 'What does it take to Win')

Work closely with the Coaching team at National Academy level to align the performance pathway and drive an ENG coaching philosophy.

Attend meetings with external stakeholders ensuring at all times England Netball is presented in an appropriate and professional manner to its stakeholders, partners, the International Federation and other Netball nations.

Act as a positive role model, ambassador and advocate for the sport and the NGB, nurturing and developing positive relationships that will promote and support the strategic development of England Netball.
